2011 Golf Memberships

Established in 1912, The Guelph Country Club has been a leader in providing recreation and hospitality services for 98 years in Guelph and Wellington County.

Rates

The 2011 rate structure has been designed to accommodate the widest range of membership needs in the community. From full golf memberships with unlimited privileges, to weekday, intermediate, junior, and even a golden golf option for members over the age of 70. This year we are also proud to introduce an additional intermediate option as well as a seven day restricted membership. **There have been no increases in our 2011 rates and two payment options are available.** The early payment option offers a 4% discount for all memberships paid in full by January 15th of 2011. The ten month program is equal billing from January to October, on the member's account. Senior's and family discounts are available.

Capital Fund

The Club will introduce a capital fund in 2011. The capital fund will allow the purchase of maintenance equipment to ensure the ongoing quality condition of our golf course. For 2011, the fund will be utilized in the immediate purchase of a used tractor, slit seeder, and boom sprayer. The capital fund project for 2011 will aim to raise \$30,000 which will go **directly** to the purchase of this equipment. All adult golf members will be charged \$25 per month for six months from May to October on their accounts. We have used capital funds over the years to invest in curling and the club house. It is imperative that we now invest quality and essential maintenance equipment to ensure the best possible golf experience at the Country Club for the future.

Over the past year, the Country Club has made several changes in order to achieve the goal of a balanced budget for 2011, including substantial staff and wage adjustments. Financial times and a competitive golf industry have made it difficult to operate on a breakeven basis. Our new business model and focus on cost containment will ensure not only a quality golf course but improved customer service, and overall member value and experience.

Credit Card Billing

As mentioned in the November newsletter, the Guelph Country Club will be introducing monthly credit card billing in 2011 to maintain accounts at current status. On the 20th of each month, any outstanding balance from the previous month will be charged to the members' credit card. Statements will be available on the first of the month, which will give the member time to review their statements, and to use other methods of payment if they wish prior to the 20th of the month. The charging system has passed PADSS Visa Certification and has the same security levels as offered by the major financial institutions. We would ask that all members advise either General Manager Dave Vogel, or Accountant Ken Steffler of their credit card information as soon as possible.
