Terms and Conditions

- 1 As a Member, Non Member or Guest of The Guelph Country Club I agree to abide by all rules of conduct and dress code. Inappropriate conduct will not be tolerated and could lead to the withdrawal of club privileges.
- 2 Club management and staff have the authority to enforce all rules and regulations.

- 6 All curling fees are payable by October 1 each year. A 2% monthly service charge will apply to all overdue accounts. All \$10 guest fees are due before using the ice. Guests must be registered and fee paid at the bar.
- 7 All accounts 60 days in arrears will be reviewed by the Board of Directors which may result in suspension of playing privileges.
- 8 Arrears in fees from a previous year will result in a withdrawal of Club privileges until the account is brought into good standing.
- 9 Children in the Club must be supervised by an adult at all times.

2009 - 2010 Season

Welcome back to the Club for another curling season of fun with the renewal of old friendships and the making of new ones. The convener of your draws will be making themselves known when the leagues start. If you have any questions/ concerns please bring them to their attention.

Changes/Information for the 2009 - 2010 season

- 1 The Board of Directors has approved a 2.5 % fee increase.
- 2 The Board of Directors has approved retaining the Drop In and evening leagues Guest fees at \$10.
- 3 The Board of Directors has approved a maximum of 6 players registered on any team. The fee for a 5th or 6th player is \$154 for one session. The 5th or 6th team members are eligible to spare in any other session. All league teams must have 4 registered players.
- 4 The Board of Directors has approved the continuation of the \$32 capital equipment fee. It applies to all registered curlers and is in section C of the registration form
- 5 Enclosed is your registration form. It is the same format as last year. The fees this year are GST included on the registration form. Please read and sign the terms and Indemnity and include your payment with your completed form.
- 6 By November 15 you will receive a directory of all members. Use this directory to arrange spares. If you invite a guest to curl please register them at the bar, have them read and sign the Indemnity form and pay \$10.
- 7 As we open the 2009 season a new roof has been installed over the equipment room.
- 8 The club again plans to have a "Rookie League". This will be a learn to curl league which runs all season. It will include off ice and on ice activities. It's goal will be to provide non curlers who are reluctant to just come out and join a league an opportunity to learn about the game and on ice training. It will likely be 1 hour per week and by the end of the curling season these members will be ready to join regular league play. Last year's program brought out 22 Rookies and we hope many of those will join our Leagues this year and continue their fun curling experience. If you know anyone who fits this league please encourage them to join.
